**Note:** The monthly values taken into account were as follows: gross minimum wage of 4,050 lei in 2025, corresponding to a net wage (after deductions and taxes) of 2,635 lei (three dependents, including two children) and 2,595 lei (one dependent child), respectively; these values are higher than the minimum net wage of 2,574 lei due to deductions; universal child allowance of 292 lei; the aid for families with children granted through the VMI (formerly the "support allowance") of 286 lei and 228 lei (depending on family income), respectively, and the social aid granted through the minimum inclusion income of 915 lei for a family of four. The energy consumption supplement is granted monthly to families with incomes below the minimum inclusion income of 1,386 lei/person (and to single persons with incomes below 2,053 lei) and consists of a supplement for electricity (20 lei), natural gas (10 lei), thermal energy (10 lei), and fuel consumption (20 lei). If the household uses only electricity, 70 lei/month is granted. We did not take into account the heating allowance granted during the cold season, nor the social vouchers worth 125 lei that are granted every six months, as their effects are only seasonal.

For 2025, the NIS has not yet calculated the relative monetary poverty threshold, so we used the threshold for 2024, i.e. 4,070 lei/month, obtained from the value of 23,262 lei/year reported by the NIS for 2024. We applied the equivalence scale used by Eurostat (OECD-2 scale), which weights each additional adult at 0.5 and each child at 0.3.
